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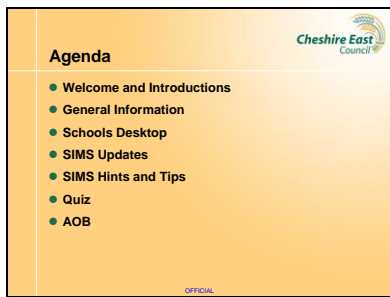

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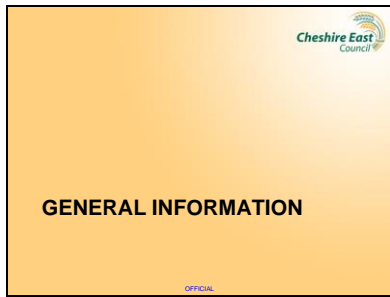

<b>Printing and Windows 10</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Issue with windows 10 and PDFs</li><li>• Affects printers with a code</li><li>• Need to default PDFs to open with Adobe rather than Edge</li><li>• A fix can be put in but it doesn't always work with different versions of Adobe</li><li>• Find a PDF – right click- open with – choose Adobe and tick always open with</li></ul>

<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• New Centranet not available for school</li><li>• Need to use School Specific Content of the top right hand side</li><li>• If any sites missing let Service desk know and links can be added</li><li>• Looking at options for school</li></ul>

<b>Windows 7/Server 2008</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Windows 7 and Server 2008 out of support on 14 January 2020</li><li>• Need to upgrade to Windows 10/Server 2016</li><li>• Need a much higher spec of pc, may need to budget for new equipment</li><li>• Have been upgrading and testing on individual pcs. Can sometime upgrade to solid state drives</li><li>• Carried out surveys in supported schools and advised on ICT plans</li></ul>

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

<b>Google Classroom / Chromebooks</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Google classroom - can be used in classroom for lessons</li><li>• Management of devices/users etc</li><li>• Can use chromebooks which are cheaper than laptops/ipads</li><li>• Can use Neverware to reprovision old desktops/laptops</li><li>• Have a company that can give free training for admin management and use in classroom</li></ul>

<b>Google GSuite</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● Shared Drive – Shared spaces belong to the team rather than an individual</li><li>● If the individual leaves the shared drive and content remains</li><li>● Google takeout – If pupils have data then they can be exported to a standard google account so the pupil can take with them</li></ul>

<b>Managed Internet Update</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● Existing supplier contract expires at the start of 2021:<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>– Procurement is ongoing for a replacement supplier</li><li>– Outcome will be known during December 2019</li><li>– School engagement planned to January 2020 to communicate outcome and any new arrangements for 2020/21 academic year</li></ul></li><li>● The priority is ensuring continuity of service and best value for circa 200 Schools and Academies that are currently buying the Service</li><li>● It is anticipated that all schools will need to be migrated to the new service by September 2020</li><li>● New contract will offer significantly different services, in terms of both available technology and pricing</li></ul>

<b>Managed Internet Update</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● Potential suppliers are being asked to outline their capability to offer a fully managed service for schools: This could include an option for schools to contract directly with the new supplier</li><li>● We would encourage schools to evaluate the new supplier offer before looking at the wider market place to source their own internet service provider</li><li>● New Crown Commercial Services framework called Education Technology (RM6103) also provides a direct route to market for all education establishments, including schools and academies: <a href="https://www.crowncommercial.gov.uk/agreements/RM6103">https://www.crowncommercial.gov.uk/agreements/RM6103</a></li></ul>	
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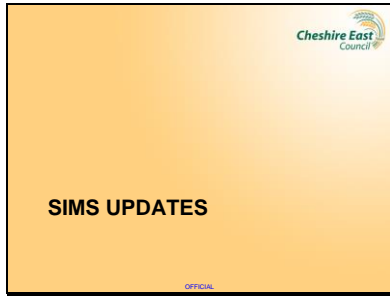

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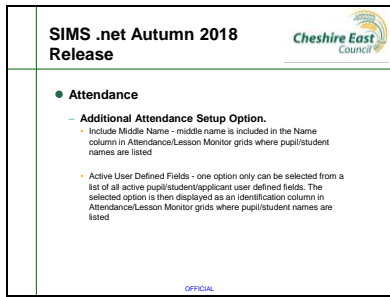

**SIMS .net Autumn 2019 Release** 

- **Assessment (Cont)**
  - **Viewing Previous Years Attainment in Programme of Study Tracking Entry**
    - It is now possible to display as additional columns in Programme of Study Tracking Entry
      - a pupil/student's Previous Years Attainment for a subject by selecting the option from the Show/Hide drop-down menu. This option is available where the NC Year selected is Year 1 through to Year 6.
  - **Consolidating Subject Results in the Summative Report Outputs**
    - The Summative Attainment and Summative Progress reports now enable you to view the results for Reading, Writing and Maths as columns in a single report by selecting the Core Report check box in Selection Parameters. This function is available where the Year selected is Year 1 through to Year 6.

**School Census Spring 2019 Return** 

- **New Data Items**
  - The following data items are being collected for the first time:
    - Not applicable to Nursery schools
      - Permanent exclusion review date
      - Permanent exclusion review result
      - Permanent exclusion reinstatement date
      - Permanent exclusion review SEN expert.
    - Applicable to Primary and All-Through schools only
      - Teachers on planning and preparation time (PPA)
      - Reason for class size exception
      - Number of pupils to which the class size exception reason applies.

**School Census Spring 2019 Return** 

- **Planning, Preparation and Assessment Teachers**
  - The new PPA Teachers column in the Classes panel enables the recording of the number of teachers on planning, preparation and assessment time at the 'selected time' on census day. This information is required for infant class (Reception or Key Stage 1) only.
  - Information regarding PPA teachers is also available in the Class report.

**School Census Spring 2019 Return** 

- **Class Size Exceptions**
  - The Classes panel now enables the recording of the reason(s) for exceptional class sizes.
  - An indication as to the Number of classes with unexplained excess is displayed at the top of the panel.
  - The new Class Size Exceptions button is activated only when an exceptional class size is highlighted. Clicking the Class Size Exceptions button displays the new Class Size Exceptions dialog, where the exception details can be recorded.
  - Class size exceptions definition: the total number of children per teacher in a Reception or Key Stage 1 class must be less than 31.
    - Children = on-roll plus guest pupils.
    - Teachers = teachers plus PPA teachers.

Information regarding class size exception reasons is also available in the Class report.

- **Section 9. Classes**
  - "Snapshot" time taken to log activity.
  - Selected time to record this is based on:  
**Last digit of schools Establishment number**

0, 1 or 5	= 1 hour / period before the end of morning school
2, 3 or 6	= 1 hour / period after the start of afternoon school
4, 7, 8 or 9	= 1 hour / period after the start of morning school

<p><b>School Census Spring 2019 Return</b> </p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● <b>Changes to Detail Reports</b></li><li>- The Class report now displays the PPA Teachers and Class Size Exception Reasons columns. A key to class size exception reasons is also included in the report.</li><li>- The Exclusions report has been updated to include the Exclusion Reviews table, which provides final governor review outcome information about permanent and fixed exclusions.</li><li>- The Leavers Basic Details report now displays the new Report Criteria for exclusions and the report displays the applicable data.</li></ul> <p><small>OFFICIAL</small></p>

<p><b>School Census Spring 2019 Return</b> </p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● <b>Create &amp; Validate Routine</b></li><li>- When creating and validating the return, a message is displayed if there are permanent exclusions during the collection period without a corresponding final governor review result.</li><li>- The message advises the user to check whether the permanent exclusions are ongoing and allows them to cancel or continue with the process.</li></ul> <p><small>OFFICIAL</small></p>
